USFWS, DWR propose building Delta research center

The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and DWR have proposed [building a science and research center in the Delta](#) to focus on the Delta and the San Francisco Bay ecosystems. The Delta Research Station would consist of an estuarine research station, managed by DWR, and a fish technology center, managed by the USFWS.

The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has expanded its Fisheries Restoration Grants Program into the Central Valley for 2016 to support the recovery of the Central Valley's winter-run and spring-run Chinook salmon and steelhead populations. MWD Bay-Delta Committee posts meeting video


