The Delta Conservancy's Board of Directors has voted to approve, conditionally approve, or reserve \$5.9 million to fund [eight projects in the Delta](#). The Conservancy's Ecosystem Restoration and Water Quality Grant Program administers Proposition 1 funding for projects that advance ecosystem restoration, water quality, and agricultural sustainability in the Delta.
