



SWRCB grants 27-day extension for objections to California WaterFix hearing documents

The State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) has issued a [ruling](#) responding to the multiple requests for an extension of the deadline to submit objections to DWR's and Reclamation's documents, which support their intentions for California WaterFix and are part of the joint water-right change petition hearing. This deadline has been extended 27 days to July 12.
