RESOLUTION NO. 5874 (13)

**A Resolution of the Council of the City of Lompoc,
County of Santa Barbara, State of California,
to Adopt a Groundwater Management Plan**

WHEREAS, the California Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 3030 to provide local public agencies increased management authority over their groundwater resources and subsequently, Senate Bill 1938 to expand the authority under AB 3030 by requiring Groundwater Management Plans to provide for eligibility for grant funds for groundwater related projects (California Water Code Sections 10750 *et. seq.*); and

WHEREAS, the State of California has emphasized the development of integrated regional solutions by local agencies for water management and coordinating conjunctive management of surface and groundwater to improve the regional supply, reliability and quality of water; and

WHEREAS, the City is an urban supplier of water, providing water to approximately 40,000 citizens; and

WHEREAS, the City's Groundwater Management Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A, (the Plan) meets the State requirements in compliance with the California Water Code and was coordinated with other local water districts and water users in the Lompoc Groundwater Basin; and

WHEREAS, the Plan shall be periodically reviewed and the City shall make any amendments or changes to the Plan, which are indicated by the review; and

WHEREAS, the City's current Urban Water Management Plan adopted in 2010, addresses the current water supply, the Groundwater Basin Management Plan addresses maintaining a long-term, sustainable, and reliable supply of high quality groundwater for the beneficial use of water customers in the City of Lompoc service area; and

WHEREAS, the City will file the Plan with the California Department of Water Resources upon adoption of the final Plan by the City Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOMPOC, CALIFORNIA,
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**


SECTION 1. The Groundwater Management Plan is hereby adopted and staff is directed to file the Plan with the California Department of Water Resources and to pursue future grant funds.


