

RESOLUTION 2005-09

RECLAMATION DISTRICT NO. 2068 GROUNDWATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the District pursuant to Part 2.75 of Division 6 of the Water Code was provided the opportunity to develop a management program for the groundwater resources within the District boundaries, and

WHEREAS, the District did adopt, on January 9, 1997, a Reclamation District No. 2068 Groundwater Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, it was deemed by the District Board to be advantageous to the District and to landowners presently utilizing groundwater resources and those not yet having access to the groundwater, that such groundwater management plan be updated to conform to the requirements of SB 1938 and other appropriate California requirements in order to continue to exercise local jurisdiction over the management of groundwater,

WHEREAS, the Groundwater Management Plan will further ongoing efforts to protect groundwater and the interdependent resources in the District groundwater area, will facilitate the collection of information to further understand and evaluate policies and programs for the protection of groundwater resources in the area of the District, and will assist in the ongoing efforts to investigate the feasibility of conjunctive use programs to the benefit of District landowners,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the District Board of Trustees adopts an updated Reclamation District No. 2068 Groundwater Management Plan, dated December 8, 2005,

RESOLVED FURTHER, the Board of Trustees finds that the adoption of the Reclamation District No. 2068 Groundwater Management Plan, December 8, 2005, is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act. (CEQA Guidelines § § 15061,15306,15307,15308 and 15262).
