The Regulations became effective as of November 16, 2015 and the first basin boundary modification submission period opens January 1, 2016 through March 31, 2016. This webinar will describe the general requirements of the regulation, demonstrate of the resources available to local agencies, demonstrate the use of the online [Basin Boundary Modification Request System](#), and answer questions during the webinar.
