

**LAKE DON PEDRO COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
2015 IRWM Implementation Grant Proposal**

Groundwater Management Compliance

The Proposal includes one groundwater project that will directly affect groundwater levels or quality. This CWC 10753 provision for groundwater management plans applies to groundwater basins, which are defined in CWC10721 as follows:

“(b) "Basin" means a groundwater basin or subbasin identified and defined in Bulletin 118 or as modified pursuant to Chapter 3 (commencing with Section 10722).”

Section 10722 states:

“10722. Unless other basin boundaries are established pursuant to this chapter, a basin's boundaries shall be as identified in Bulletin 118.

10722.2. (a) A local agency may request that the department revise the boundaries of a basin, including the establishment of new subbasins.”

However, the wells that are being constructed are located within the fractured bedrock foothills, and are not within a designated groundwater basin as defined by the Department of Water Resources Bulletin 118. Therefore, a groundwater management plan is not required for this area.

The groundwater user that will receive funding from the grant is the following:
