Calculation Review	Attachment 2	Based on the provided backup documentation, Measure 5's overall water savings (the difference between Step 1 and 2) has been adjusted so that the project possesses a water savings of 11.826 MG/year. Measures 2, 3 and 6 were removed from the savings calculations because they are not part of a water efficiency program. As a result of all adjustments, the water savings per million dollars decreased and the energy savings per million dollars increased.
