Calculation Review	Attachment 2	Each measure was adjusted up 26% to match the original Total Proposal Cost of \$340,642. The reviewer adjusted Energy Intensities in Step 7 and Step 9. In addition, measures 2, 3 and 6 were removed from the savings calculations because these projects are not part of a water efficiency program. Adjusting for the energy savings and project costs, the water savings per million dollars increased and the energy savings per million dollars decreased.
