Calculation Review	Attachment 2	For the input provided in step 10, the reviewer is unable to verify calculations due to lack of supporting documentation. Therefore, Step 10 is adjusted to "0". Based upon the applicant's location, Step 9 has been adjusted to 534 KWh/MG. As a result of the adjustments, the energy savings has been reduced.
