Calculation Review	Attachment 2	The Energy Intensity is undervalued because of a miscalculation. After recalculation Energy Intensity is adjusted to 1865 kWh/MG. Project 2 does not collectively reduce GHG emissions and also reduce water and energy use; no further adjustments were made.
Agreement Components	Attachments 3, 4, and 5	All necessary agreement component requirements are not met, as outlined in the PSP. The Tasks in the Work Plan are not presented in logical order to demonstrate the projects are implementable. Work Plan tasks do not define the main activities, including magnitude or effort, necessary to complete the task. The Budget basis of estimate does not contain hours and rates as appropriate.
DAC Benefit/Status	Attachment 7	All necessary disadvantaged community (DAC) benefit and status requirements were not met, as outlined in the PSP. Applicant does not demonstrate that at least 75% of a project benefit is directly received by the designated DAC.
