Calculation Review	Attachment 2	1. Davis and Winters do not receive imported water. Therefore, Step 6 is "0%" and Step 9 is "0". The adjustments do not affect the water and energy savings values. Furthermore, it is recognized that the energy savings provided in Step 10 is not associated to saving water; however no adjustment is made.
Agreement Components	Attachments 3, 4, and 5	All necessary agreement component requirements were not met, as outlined in the PSP. The Tasks in the Work Plan are not presented in logical order to demonstrate an implementable project. Work Plan tasks do not define the main activities, including magnitude or effort, necessary to complete the task. The Schedule is not consistent with the tasks in the Work Plan.
