**PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION**

The project would reduce water used for irrigation of non-functional turf, while reducing energy and GHG emissions, through 1) removal of 388,820 SF of non-functional turf at 12 sites; replace with drought-tolerant California native plants; 2) replace inefficient irrigation system components with high-efficiency devices and controllers; 3) pipe replacement/repair on existing water lines and deficient irrigation lines to reduce water losses; and 4) public outreach/education to the local community on the importance of water use efficiency and conservation strategies.
