PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION

The California Youth Energy Services Program will implement the following measures through their Green House Call service: Installation of the “Drop-A-Brick” device in all eligible (>1.6 GPF) toilets, reducing the gallons needed per flush, provision of water-efficient bath and kitchen aerators, as well as showerheads, in communities where local water districts or departments are unable to provide them, saving both water and energy, and provision of water-saving precision sprinkler nozzles for pop-up sprinklers.

Calculation Review	Attachment 2	Water savings values were not converted from gallons/year to MG/year. Water Savings has been recalculated to be 56.033 MG/year. As a result, the water and energy values have been reduced.
Agreement Components	Attachments 3, 4, and 5	All necessary agreement component requirements were not met, as outlined in the PSP. The Work Plan does not address CEQA compliance. The Schedule is not consistent with the tasks in the Work Plan; and does not show the timing and duration of the tasks. The Basis of the Budget estimate does not in result in costs presented in the Budget. All Budget estimates are not justified as to their use and magnitude.
