PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION

The project would encourage water and energy conservation through rebates for water efficient washing machines, dishwashers, smart irrigation controllers and waterless urinals offered to residents and commercial water users in each of the four member cities. These water conservation measures will reduce overall water usage for each member city, which will reduce SGVMWD's supplemental water requirement and therefore lead to decreased imported water deliveries.
