PROPOSAL DESCRIPTION

The objective of the Pacific Coast Highway Recycled Water Distribution Bottleneck Upsizing Project is to improve the existing recycled water system and eliminate the bottleneck in the current system by replacing the recycled water distribution line from Recycled Water Pump Station No. 2 (RPS 2) to the intersection of 9th Street and Pacific Coast Highway, in the city of Laguna Beach.
