Work may include connecting multiple drains for pupfish connectivity and increased water availability and reliability for dust control, mitigating potential dust emissions on identified priority areas of exposed lakebed, creating connectivity to the West Interception Ditch of the Species Conservation Habitat (SCH) project to convey water from the drains near the SCH expansion areas toward the Kane Spring project site, maintaining existing wetlands, including habitat for Yuma Ridgway's Rail and/or California Black Rails, and creating a network of trails, viewing stations, and other visitor amenities for recreational access to the site.
