Nearby Parking

- Additional short and long-term 10-hour metered parking is available in front of the building and on all surrounding streets. Parking meters take coins and credit cards or can be paid for using the ParkMobile App.
- Public parking can also be found in the following garages that are within two blocks of the building:
 - [500 R Street Garage](#) (operated by SP+ Parking), enter off of 5th Street, between Q and R Streets.
 - [Lincoln Plaza Garage](#) (CalPERS building), enter off of Q Street, between 4th and 5th Streets.

Sac State Downtown Parking Lot - 304 S Street - 63 spaces

- Enter through gate on S Street
- Valid Sacramento State parking permits are honored in the 304 S Street parking lot.
- Daily parking is available to purchase utilizing the ParkMobile website or app <https://parkmobile.io/>
 - Parking Zone #19407
 - Parking is enforced by the City of Sacramento Parking Division

- Parking lot space is limited. There are 63 spots in total including “tandem parking”. There are 4 disabled spots.
