- Idea Infra2: Andrew Schwarz, SWP Climate Action Manager, State Water Project Adaptation Strategy – presentation will cover the recently released report detailing climate adaptation strategies for the SWP and how those strategies can provide resilience for state water supplies.
- Idea Infra3: Department staff in the Sustainable Groundwater Management Office –
  presentation will focus on opportunities that the Department has developed and
  highlighted to support regional groundwater recharge as well as share Department
  knowledge of regional and local efforts and hurdles.
