



Flood Emergency Response Statewide Grants

Round 3 Application Period Anticipated Fall 2017

Objective. Led by the California Department of Water Resources (DWR), the objective of the Flood Emergency Response Grants is to improve local flood emergency response in California and contribute to increased public safety. California public agencies with primary responsibility for flood emergency response and coordination are eligible to apply for this competitive grant. The geographic scope of this grant is Statewide, outside of the legal Delta. A similar grant is available for the legal Delta.



Funding. The "Safe Drinking Water, Water Quality & Supply, Flood Control, River & Coastal Protection Bond Act of 2006" (Proposition 84) provides funding to improve local flood emergency response. To date, \$10 million has been awarded in two solicitations for this grant and an additional \$5 million is being made available for the third solicitation.

Projects. Examples of eligible projects include:

- Preparing or updating local flood emergency plans,
- Coordinating flood emergency planning and preparedness, including training and regional exercises,
- Developing processes to effectively communicate and coordinate response to flood emergencies,
- Collecting and exchanging flood information,
- Purchasing and installing equipment needed for emergency communication, and
- Acquiring and staging flood fight materials.
